1E SBCCC 300.1 Tuition for Curriculum Programs (a) Tuition Rates. The State Board shall set a uniform tuition rate per credit hour and a maximum tuition amount per academic term for resident and non-resident students consistent with actions taken by the General Assembly.	
Tuition (In-State)	\$76 / credit hr. to a maximum per semester of \$1,216, based upon 16 credits hours of instruction
Tuition (Out-of-State)	\$268 / credit hr. up to a maximum per semester of \$4,288, based upon 16 credits hours of instruction
